
Resizing Images using the PIXLR Editor <http://pixlr.com>

Overview


PIXLR is a cloud-based set of image tools and utilities, including a photo editor that is similar to Adobe Photoshop. A tutorial is available at <https://support.pixlr.com/hc/en-us/sections/200581900-Pixlr-Editor>. There are also paid versions of the software with additional features available for a small monthly or yearly fee.

Procedure for Resizing Images Using PIXLR


1. Open a web browser and go to <https://pixlr.com/> and scroll down until you see the PIXLR Editor and click on the **Launch Web App**.




2. Click on the *Create a New Image* the exact size you want.




3. Name the new image, and set the width & height to the exact number of pixels you want, and then click the *Transparent* check box if you don't want the image to have a background and then click *OK*. In the example below, we are creating an image block for site using the small slide template 600 x 300 pixels.




4. Next, open the image you want to size. Click on the *Image* tab and select *Image Size*.




5. Make sure *Constrain proportions* is checked




6. Change either the width or the height to the exact measure you need, and click *OK*. In the example below we changed the width from 864 to 600 and the height became 400.



7. Click on the *Edit* menu and click on *Select All*




8. Go back to the Edit Menu and Click on Copy.



9. Click on the blank slide you created in step 3.



10. Click on the *Edit* menu and select *Paste* from the drop-down menu.



11. Move the photo around until you are happy with how it displays, and go to the *File* menu and select *Save*.
